

Learning Objective Worksheet

1. Identify the relevant training needs using the Inventory (Tool 3) and Field Observation Worksheet (Tool 2).
2. Make sure the general objectives set by the educational institution are consistent with the specific objectives you choose.
3. Translate the identified needs into objectives using the statement “**Upon completion of this field placement / clinical experience, I will be able to . . .**”
4. Answer the question “**What do I mean by . . .?**”
5. Choose and state knowledge, skill and attitude objectives.
6. Using the guidelines, formulate the specific objectives you choose.
 - a) Formulate a knowledge objective using a **general verb** followed by the content of that objective.
 - b) Formulate a skill objective using a general verb (know how to, learn how to), followed by an **action verb** expressive of performance or achievement.
 - c) Formulate an attitude objective using a general verb (know how to, learn how to), followed by a **verb expressive of an attitude, belief, feeling, value or opinion**.
