

How to give immediate feedback after an event:

1. Find a quiet spot that is private for a one-on-one discussion.
2. Meet with the student as soon as possible after the incident.
3. Stay in the present.
4. Make your comments specific.
5. Limit the amount of information.
6. Encourage the student to present their view of the situation.
7. Avoid a flattering or accusatory tone of voice.
8. Don't create a win-lose situation.
